From the flowers we collect nectar and pollen, while we are doing that we drop little pieces of pollen from one flower to another to help them grow better






Most bees die while out foraging when their wings wear out



Old wings








### Stages from an Egg to a Larvae in days





In the life cycle of an insect the pupal stage follows the larval stage and precedes adulthood (imago).

It is during the time of pupation, that the adult structures of the insect are formed whilst the larval structures are broken down.




